We are particularly interested in candidates with a strong background in analysis, numerical analysis, applied mathematics or computational mathematics. We value experience in working with diverse student populations, student mentoring and academic outreach. Candidates must demonstrate a deep commitment to effective instruction at the undergraduate and graduate levels using evidence-based teaching strategies. The position will require supervision of undergraduate and graduate research projects and theses. The University of New Haven is strengthening its undergraduate programs in mathematics and building expertise in key areas of interdisciplinary applied mathematics as it moves forward with a new masters program in mathematics. Women and minority candidates are encouraged to apply.
